

Map Coordinates

Introduction to 'Map Coordinates' for ten year olds could start with a picture like this. (if the Cub Scout Leader is a male, have someone white out the hair and skirt and draw in short hair and trousers. Then photocopy for use with the Cub Scouts)

Remember - always read across first then up.

Story for Cub Scouts: Think of the map as a mountain in the distance. They have to walk across to the mountain before they can climb up.

Example of use of this map. Ask Cub Scouts what is in D4? (Cub Scout Leader's face.)

Ask what's in K6? (Legs and feet.) Put an x in E1.
