

COOPERATION GAMES

Animal Line-up

Equipment: none

How to play: This is a great exercise to promote co-operation and group communication.

Cubs are each secretly given the name of an animal. Animals should vary in size from very small (a flea) to huge (beluga whale). Be creative! Make sure that all animals are different and easy to act out. Group members are then told to arrange themselves in order of their animal size, but they must do so in **COMPLETE SILENCE!** They should use actions and any other type of non-verbal communication to achieve this goal. When they think they have finished, they should signal a leader, and say their animal out loud to check their order. This is best done first in smaller groups so cubs can get the idea, and then adding the groups together so they must re-arrange their order.
